“GOING BACK TO SCHOOL”

We know you're busy, so that's why we've prepared this quick easy guide to enroll at **Indiana Wesleyan University's online degree programs.**

But for those of you who have basically made up your mind and want to know what steps you need to take, this is it.

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OVERVIEW

- Indiana Wesleyan has over 50,000 graduates of which 34,000 are adult students.
- Indiana Wesleyan University has about 14,000 currently enrolled students.
- Founded in 1920, the main campus is in Marion, Indiana.
- Learning Centers throughout Indiana, Kentucky and Ohio.

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OVERVIEW

- Ranked Best Master's Degree College in Midwest by *Newsweek*
- More students enrolled in graduate business programs than any other school in Indiana, *Indianapolis Business Journal*
- For nearly 100 years, IWU had provided a quality Christian education with a focus on leadership development. That includes not only having the appropriate skills to succeed in a career, but the ability to think critically from a moral foundation that leads to good choices and decisions.

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OVERVIEW

Indiana Wesleyan University

- Indiana Wesleyan is **Regionally Accredited** by the North Central Association of Schools and Colleges.
- You will be considered **Full-time** student for financial aid purposes, typically, there is enough in the student loan program to cover the cost of the entire program.
- The only money out of pocket that you will need to begin is a **\$25 application fee** and a \$100 book deposit once accepted. (The application fee is good forever.)

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OVERVIEW

- You will take one class at a time for approximately 5 weeks for associate's and bachelor's programs.
- You will never have to go anywhere to take an exam, come to campus or meet with study team members.
- Books and materials will be delivered to your home or work address each and every time, no need to order books.
- You do not have to be online the same time as your classmates or facilitator.

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OVERVIEW

- You will be graded on a four point scale; A, B, C, etc.
- Your credits from previous college coursework will generally transfer in toward the bachelor's program as long as you had a grade of "C" or above, went to a regionally accredited college and the class was a 100 level or higher.
- It does not matter how old your credits are or what the subject areas were. Typically, they all transfer.
- The Associate's programs are 26 months which includes the breaks.
- The Bachelor's programs are 18 to 22 months

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OVERVIEW

- The associate's degrees requires **proof of high school graduation**
- The bachelor's degrees require **60 or more semester credits** with a grade of "C" or higher from 100 level or higher classes.
- Work experience requirements for all programs is **2 years of full-time work experience** beyond high school, (full-time is considered 30 hours or more a week), Part time work experience is counted but as a ratio of full-time work experience. For example, 1 year of part-time work is considered 4 months of full-time work.

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OVERVIEW

- You will be enrolled throughout the year, with breaks occurring for two weeks at Christmas and New Years and other times throughout the year. You will receive about 8 to 12 weeks off for a 2 year program.
- You can expect to set aside 8 to 15 hours for study each week for reading and preparation of assignments and group projects.
- Tuition cost is the same for all students regardless of whether you live in Indiana or outside of Indiana. Everyone pays the same.

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ASSOCIATE'S OVERVIEW

- Any of our associate's programs can lead into any of our 6 bachelor programs.
- You do not have to have an associate's degree to go on for a bachelor's degree, simply 60 credits or more.

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BACHELOR'S OVERVIEW

- For those of you seeking a bachelor's degree or will want to go on for a bachelor's degree, the following information is important.
- To graduate, you need a 124 credits. If you earn your associate's degree from us, this will provide you with 62 credits. Many of the bachelor's programs (which includes the "major" of your 4 year degree) are 40 credit hours long.
- For example, the BSM or Bachelor of Science in Management is 40 credit hours. If you earn 62 in the associate's program and then 40 in the Bachelor's program this will provide you with 102.
- You will still need 22 more credits to graduate.

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BACHELOR'S OVERVIEW

- You will be assigned an Academic Advisor once we review and evaluate your transcripts to determine how many credits you have. Your Academic Advisor will assist you in determining your options for completing the other 22 credits.
- Keep in mind, as long as you have 60 semester credits with a grade of "C" or higher and 100 level or higher, you can begin the bachelor's program. You can work at the other credits you need at your leisure either before, during or even after you complete the 18 month program.

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BACHELOR'S OVERVIEW

- Options for completing these other credits consist of the following:
- Professional Schools and Training or PST. We have a Portfolio Specialist at 1 800 621-8667, who will help you to determine if any of your professional schools and training may count toward college credit. We can only do this once you have applied and have been evaluated.
- Testing out of classes through the CLEP (College Level Examination Program). This program has been around since 1905 and there are a handful of exams where adults have a good success at passing them. They are fairly inexpensive, about \$75 or so and you can earn 3 or 6 credits in a 45 minute or 90 minute exam. Your Academic Advisor will assist you with this.
- Taking an elective class online from Indiana Wesleyan University Online or another college or university of your choice.

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MASTER'S OVERVIEW

- You do not have to be online the same time as your classmates or facilitator.
- You will be graded on a four point scale; A, B, C, etc.
- The MBA and MSM does not require the GMAT.
- A grade point of 2.5 is needed for full acceptance into the MBA or MSM degree program; 2.25 to 2.49 for provisional acceptance. For those with a grade point average of less than 2.25 a one page letter to the admissions review committee is required. You may be accepted or denied based on the letter and other factors.
- You will be enrolled throughout the year, with breaks occurring for two weeks at Christmas and New Years and other times throughout the year. You will receive about 8 to 12 weeks off for a 2 year program.

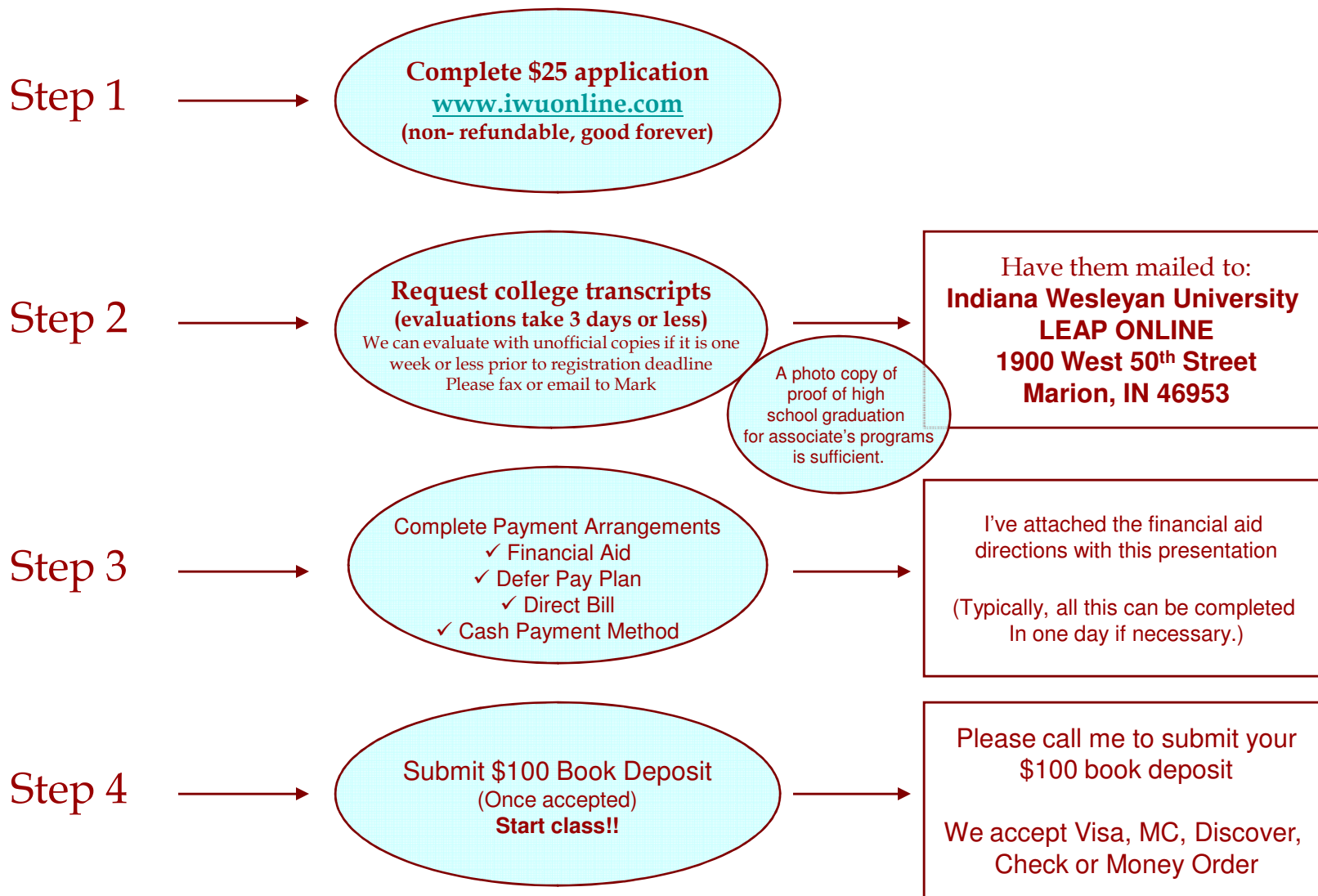

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PAYMENT OPTIONS

Cash Payment –

You may pay as you go, paying for one class at a time in most cases, however, a few programs require you to pay for the first two courses and then one at a time afterwards.

Direct Bill –

If your employer will allow us to bill them directly, then all you need is a voucher faxed to me prior to the registration deadline which is 4 p.m. two weeks prior to the date of your class start.

Defer Pay –

For those with full tuition reimbursement, or nearly full tuition reimbursement and you have the extra money to pay for the difference, then the defer pay plan would work well for you.

You simply pay us 30 days after each class is over using a credit card; MC, Visa or Discover and then you submit your receipt from us to your employer for reimbursement.

You will need a copy of your employers reimbursement policy, credit card and the defer pay plan form which I will send to you as we get closer to the deadline.

Directions for Financial Aid Completion

2008-2009 Academic Year

Four forms are necessary before you begin class in order to process Student loans or grants. These forms may be completed online.

FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid)
Entrance Counseling
Federal Stafford Loan Request
MPN (Master Promissory Note)

1.) **FAFSA**

Before filing your FAFSA, go to www.fafsa.ed.gov and request a PIN. This can be done at the PIN [site](#) on the main FAFSA web page. Your PIN will then be emailed to you within 1-3 business days.

Once a PIN is received, go back to the FAFSA website above and complete your FAFSA electronically.

File **2008-2009 FAFSA**, using your **2007 taxes**.

Be sure to include IWU's school code of **001822** and note that you will be a **FULLTIME** student.

Note: If you previously filed a FAFSA last year, go to the FAFSA website homepage and select "Fill out Renewal FAFSA"

2.) **Entrance Loan Counseling Session** (often referred to as Entrance interview)

Go to the Indiana Wesleyan University website at www.indwes.edu/financialaid

Select "**Financial Aid for APS**"

Select "**Financial Aid Forms**" and choose the degree program for which you are applying

Choose "**APS Application/Lender Selection**" (link will be in red)

The College Lender List.com site will appear

Under Step 1, click the **HERE** button to complete Nelnet entrance loan counseling

Complete loan counseling and **PRINT "Entrance Counseling Complete" to use for your confirmation page.**

Close browser to return to the "Preferred Stafford Lender List" site

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FINANCIAL AID DIRECTIONS

3.) Federal Stafford Loan Request form (often referred to as APS APP)

Scroll down the page to the lender selections on the left

Click on a lender's name to fill out the "Federal Stafford Loan Request form". After completion, **PRINT** the completed form before hitting the "submit" button. Use this page as your confirmation and then click submit.

4.) Master Promissory Note (often referred to as MPN)

Follow the online process to complete the MPN

Click "continue" button

Click on Student MPN button

Fill in Social Security number and click "continue"

Complete demographic information

Read and choose "yes" for MPN electronic signature

Verify your demographic information and click "continue"

Enter references and click "continue"

Verify confirmation, read, and click "continue"

Read "Promise to pay", click "continue"

Complete Electronic Signature by checking the "I certify..." box and typing in your name, date, and password.

PRINT "Next Steps" page that states "We have received your completed application/promissory note". **Please write your name on this page and use as your confirmation**

Then click "Print MPN" for your records

Please make sure you click "**LOG OUT**" so your MPN will be saved
